Apply only as directed. Apply during the growing season. The Andersons Professional Turf™ Products 32-3-10 fertilizer provides grass with nitrogen, phosphate and potash for maintaining strong, vigorous turf.

The nitrogen in this product is all readily available which makes this product excellent for fall feedings or whenever a quick visual response is desired.

This product is dust free and free flowing. The uniform particle sizing assures easy and accurate applications.

Application Rate:

3.1 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.

For all applications:

- Apply to dry foliage.
- Water in after application with a minimum of 0.2 inches to help move particles into the turf canopy.
- Do not collect clippings for at least one mowing following application to avoid particle pick-up.

Cool Season Grasses:

- Apply at the **MEDIUM RATE**.

Warm Season Grasses:

- Apply at the **MEDIUM RATE** every 4-6 weeks during the period of active growth.

WHEN AND HOW TO USE:

In the spring, or as soon as weather and ground conditions permit, apply 3.1 lbs. of this product per 1,000 sq. ft. Repeat every four to six weeks throughout the growing season or as often as the turf requires feeding.

To ensure that you have the best possible fertilization program, use fertilizers in conjunction with a soil and tissue test program operated by a state certified laboratory familiar with the soils in your region. Cooperative extension agents can provide the names of recommended labs in your area.

STORAGE AND USE

Store in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing. Use only in clean, dry spreaders. Do not leave unused product in spreaders.
